- 1. INTRODUCTION: UNDER RULES 50 SUB RULES (13) OF KARNATAKA NURSES, MIDWIFES AND HEALTH VISITORS ACT 1961, INDIRA NURSING SCHOOL FROM MANGALORE HAS APPLIED TO KARNATAKA STATE NURSING COUNCIL. UNDER SECTION 23 OF THE ACT THE INSPECTION COMMITTEE HAS INSPECTED THE SCHOOL AND SUBMITTED ITS REPORT TO THE GOVERNMENT THROUGH NURSING COUNCIL. AFTER VERIFICATION OF THE SAID REPORT THE GOVERNMENT HAS BEEN DECIDED TO GRANT THE PERMISSION TO INDIRA NURSING SCHOOL MANGALORE TO RUN THE COURSE OF DIPLOMA IN NURSING WITH EFFECT FROM 2003-2004 SUBJECT TO FOLLOW THE SOME CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS UNDER THE ACT.**

CONSIDERING THE INFLUENCE OF AUTHORITY UNDER RULES 50 SUB RULES 23 OF KARNATAKA NURSING, MIDWIFES AND HEALTH VISITORS ACT 1961, THE GOVERNMENT HAS DECIDED TO GRANT THE RECOGNISATION TO INDIRA NURSING SCHOOL MANGALORE TO RUN THE DIPLOMA IN NURSING COURSE WITH CAPACITY OF 60 STUDENTS WITH EFFECT FROM 2003-2004**

CONDITIONS

- 1. RECOGNITION MUST BE OBTAINED FROM THE KARNATAKA NURSING COUNCIL AND INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL.**
- 2. THE SYLLABUS FROM KARNATAKA NURSING COUNCIL AND INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL AND WORK PLAN FROM THE EXAMINATION BOARD OF MIDWIFERY AND NURSING SHOULD BE FOLLOWED.**



3. RULES AND REGULATIONS BOUND BY THE INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL AND KARNATAKA NURSING COUNCIL SHOULD BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED.
4. AS DIRECTED BY THE INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL AND KARNATAKA NURSING COUNCIL, THE REQUIRED FACILITIES SHOULD BE PROVIDED.
5. ANY GRANTS FROM THE GOVERNMENT WILL NOT BE PROVIDED TO THESE INSTITUTIONS.
6. THE INSTITUTION SHOULD APPOINT THE ELIGIBLE AND QUALIFIED TEACHING AND NON TEACHING STAFFS.
7. INSTITUTION SHOULD PROVIDE THE LIBRARY FACILITIES WITH NURSING AND MEDICAL RELATED BOOKS AND JOURNALS ETC.
8. THE INSTITUTION SHOULD POSSESS ITS OWN HOSPITAL WITH IN 5 YEARS TIME AS PER THE RULES OF INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL.
9. THE ADMISSION OF CANDIDATES FOR 2003 KARNATAKA DIPLOMA IN GENERAL NURSING, MIDWIFERY AND PSYCHIATRY COURSE SHOULD BE DONE AS PER THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE ADMISSION OR AS PER THE RULES ISSUED BY THE STATE GOVERNMENT FROM TIME TO TIME.
